CDVac Clostridial **Polyvalent**



Vaccine for the prevention against Blackleg, Gas Gangrene, Enterotoxemia, Necrotic Hepatitis, Malignant Edema, and Sudden Death case preventive treatment produced by clostridial bacteria in cattle and sheep.

Composition: Anacultures and toxoids of *Clostridium chauvoei*, Clostridium septicum, Clostridium perfringens type C and D, Clostridium novyi type B, and Clostridium sordelli, strains isolated from clinical cases, inactivated and with aluminum hydroxide as adjuvant.

Dosage and route of administration: Cattle: 5 ml. Sheep: 3 ml; subcutaneous route. Apply two doses at an interval of 20-30 days in primoinoculation above three months old. Revaccinate once or twice a year, apply at veterinarian's discretion. Pregnant females at last quarter of pregnancy can be vaccinated.

Presentation: Bottle containing 250 ml (50 doses for cattle and 80 doses for sheep).
