CDVac Clostridial Polyvalent



Vaccine for the prevention against Blackleg, Gas Gangrene, Enterotoxemia, Necrotic Hepatitis, Malignant Edema, and Sudden Death case preventive treatment produced by clostridial bacteria in cattle and sheep.

Composition: Anacultures and toxoids of *Clostridium chauvoei*, *Clostridium septicum*, *Clostridium perfringens* type C and D, *Clostridium novyi* type B, and *Clostridium sordelli*, strains isolated from clinical cases, inactivated and with aluminum hydroxide as adjuvant.

Dosage and route of administration: Cattle: 5 ml. Sheep: 3 ml; subcutaneous route. Apply two doses at an interval of 20-30 days in primoinoculation above three months old. Revaccinate once or twice a year, apply at veterinarian's discretion. Pregnant females at last quarter of pregnancy can be vaccinated.

Presentation: Bottle containing 250 ml (50 doses for cattle and 80 doses for sheep).
