CDVac Clostrimax T



Vaccine for the prevention against Blackleg, Gas Gangrene, Enterotoxemia, Malignant Oedema, Sudden Death, Swelled Head, Hemoglobinuria, and Tetanus case preventive treatment produced by clostridial bacteria in cattle and sheep.

Composition: Anacultures and toxoids of *Clostridium chauvoei*, Clostridium septicum, Clostridium perfringens type A, B, C and D, Clostridium novyi type A, B and D (C. haemolyticum), Clostridium sordelli and Clostridium tetani, strains isolated from clinical cases, adsorbed in aluminum hydroxide adjuvant.

Dosage and route of administration: Cattle: 5 ml; sheep: 2 ml. subcutaneous route. Calves and lambs (since 3 months of age): apply two doses with an interval of 20 - 30 days.

Young and adult animals vaccinated previously: vaccinate with one dose, 1 year of initial vaccination plan, and repeat annually. Pregnant females: Vaccine can be used during gestation period.

Presentation: Bottle containing 250 ml (50 doses for cattle and 125 doses for sheep).
